

Comparative form

Short adjectives adjective + **er + than**

Long adjectives **more + adjective + than**

Peter is **taller than** Mary

Your house is **more modern than** mine.

Superlative form

Short adjectives **The + adjective + est** in/of

Long adjectives **The + most + adjective** in/of

The Nile is **the longest** river **in the world**

This is **the most interesting** book **of all**

Spelling rules

Big - bigger -the biggest

Dirty - dirtier - the dirtiest

Nice – nicer – the nicest

With some 2-syllable adjectives, we can use "-er"
OR "more":

quiet → quieter/more quiet the quietest/ the
most quiet

clever → cleverer/more clever

narrow → narrower/more narrow

simple → simpler/more simple

Irregular adjectives

Good - better – the best

Bad – worse – the worst

Much/ many – more – the most

Little - less – the least
